

Funky Logs -Sally Frey Workshop

Using a vintage log cabin quilt top I design a new quilt using lights and darks. My lights are a variety of grays and my darks are Kaffe' wonderful fabrics in blues, purples and pinks. This quilt works great by digging into your scrap bag.

75" square

Supply list: Basic sewing supplies

Sewing machine in good working order

Rotary cutter, mat and basic rulers

"Quilt in a Day" 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squaring up ruler

Fabrics:

$\frac{1}{2}$ yard of a light and dark for the center squares (I used different darks fabrics because I ran out of one fabric)

I am giving you the amount to start the quilt in class. I used many more fabrics for the strips the amount should be plenty to get started. Bring any scraps you might want to add to the quilt.

10 fat quarters of lights

10 fat quarters of darks

Pre-cutting before class

Cut center square fabric into (18) light 5" squares and the center dark into (18) dark 5" squares.

Cut all the fat quarters into (2) 2" strips. This will be enough to get started.

Bring rest of the fabric to class.

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
