Description Combine appliqué, paper piecing and color theory with this strip-friendly project from Carolyn's book, Savor Each Stitch: Studio Quilting With Mindful Design. Carolyn will walk you through the techniques involved as well as how to create your own color story with this bold and versatile project.

Level of Experience Beginner to Intermediate

finished sizes (Note: Runner-sized amounts are appropriate for class. However, other sizes and amounts are included if student desires larger project.)

53" x 701/2" throw, 11" x 251/2" runner, 36" x 471/2" wall/baby, and 841/2" x 911/2" full/queen.

Project Requirements

- __ Pattern found in Savor Each Stitch: Studio Quilting With Mindful Design, Carolyn Friedlander __ fabric Sizes are referred to in the following order: throw (runner, wall/baby, full/queen). (Note: Fabric A, B and C will be used in class. All other fabric requirements will NOT be needed in class, but will be needed for finishing project.)
 - + Fabric A (rays and sashing): 4 yards total (% yard, 1% yards, 81/4 yards) or 92 (6, 36, 195) 11/2" strips
 - + Fabric B (colored background sections): 4¼ yards total (¾ yard, 1¾ yards, 9 yards) or 60 (4, 24, 128) 2½* strips. Note: You can use assorted colors or a single color depending on the project.
 - + Fabric C (circle center): 1/2 yard (1/2 yard, 1/4 yard, 1/4 yard)
 - + Border fabric: ½ yard (½ yard, ½ yard, ¾ yard)
 - + Backing fabric: 3½ yards (% yard, 2½ yards, 7¾ yards) or 1¾ yards (% yard, 1¼ yards, 2¾ yards) if using 108"-wide fabric
 - + Binding fabric: % yard (% yard, % yard, % yard)
 - + Batting: 61" x 79" (19" x 34", 44" x 56", 93" x 100")

__ Other Supplies

- + thread for project (such as Aurifil Cotton 50wt for sewing and Aurifil 80wt for appliqué in both matching and contrasting colors)
- + appliqué needles (such as Clover Gold Eye Appliqué Needles No. 10)
- + appliqué pins (such as Clover Appliqué Size 12)
- + scissors for cutting paper
- + large fabric scissors (such as Kai 7230 9" shears)
- + small fabric scissors (such as Kai N5100 4" scissors)
- + removable marking tool (such as Pilot Frixion pen)
- + seam gauge (such as Dritz Measuring Gauge)
- + heavy paper or template plastic (for copying template)

__Optional Supplies thimble, needle threader, thread conditioner (such as Thread Heaven)
