Sarah Fielke class requirements

Sarah's charming quilt is made completely from Liberty fabrics, but you can use whatever busy prints you like. In this one day class Sarah will help you to grade the colours for your blocks, and teach her easy and accurate method for neat, flat and square log cabins with no foundations.

This list is the material requirements for the whole quilt, which finishes at 72 ½" square. If you want to make your quilt larger or smaller you will not need the same amount of fabric. We will get quite a few blocks made in class so be sure to bring fabric for more than one or two blocks.

Supply List:

- * 4" of feature print for the centre of the cabins
- * 6" each of 20 different light prints
- * 6" each of 20 different dark prints
- * 32" dark floral fabric for border (optional - it is unlikely anyone will reach the border in class)
- * Copy of "**Old Quilts New Life**" by Sarah Fielke for the pattern. each student must OWN their own copy of the book.
- * 12" square quilting ruler. This is optional but VERY useful for this class.
- * Rotary cutter, board and ruler. There is a lot of trimming in this class so I do recommend having your own board.

Before class it will be useful to cut your fabrics into 1 ½" strips. The longest of these will be 11 ½", however I don't recommend cutting them into exact lengths as we will grade them light to dark or vice versa in class.

You can cut all of the feature print in the centre of your blocks into 1 ½" squares. My feature print is little houses- keep in mind that the 4" of feature print is ONLY if you are not fussy cutting your feature squares. If you are you will need enough to fussy cut 36 squares.

There are a total of 36 blocks in the original pattern. My fabrics are all Liberty, so if you would like to achieve the same busy, fizzy look as my quilt I recommend you use small, dense prints and no solids.
