WELSH - FOLDED LOG CABIN

I LOVE to do hand work!! I learned this folded-log cabin technique many years ago in a class from master quilter Ruth Ingham. You will learn to make log cabin blocks like your grandmothers made them. No rotary cutters; just your hand to measure and a needle and thread for hand sewing.

SUPPLY LIST

Fabric:

 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards of 3 light fabrics $\frac{3}{4}$ yards of 3 dark fabrics

1/8 yard of a bright (such as red or yellow for centers)

 $\frac{1}{2}$ yard muslin

(If you prefer a scrappy look, bring a collection of darks and lights.)

Thread:

Any color 50wt cotton

Notions:

Ruler

Sewing needles

Small scissors

NOTE: We will spend the day making several blocks together. It will then be up to you as to whether you "just can't stop" or if a few is enough. There will not be time to complete the entire quilt.

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
