Quilter's Affair

Class Overview: You will be working on an approximately 54" x 66" quilt using one jelly roll with 40 - 2 1/2" strips and one other fabric.

Materials needed:

Fabric List for the entire project:

1 jelly roll with 40 - 2 1/2" x 42" strips

1 1/4 yard of a fabric that mixes well with the jelly roll

When picking these, I would look for a jelly roll that contains fabrics mostly of the same value. I found that if there was a wide variety from lights to darks, I rejected the lights and added more to the medium values in the jelly roll. You can always cut a few extra strips from your stash to throw in the mix.

The fabric that mixes well with the jelly roll could be one of the fabrics in the jelly roll you really like, or another fabric that just works with the jelly roll.

You will need backing later -- 3 1/2 yards and also batting!

Possibly you will need a binding fabric (1/2 yard) -- or your additional fabric to go with the jelly roll could be used here (if you don't use it somewhere else!)

PRE-CLASS CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From your additional fabric cut the following:

cut 2 - 6 1/2" x 42" strips. From these two strips cut 12 - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

Now just a thought, if you find a fabric that contains 6 1/2" squares of several designs, something like this would work, as long as it goes with our jelly roll. So, look for some pre-printed 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares and if you find some, you will need 12 - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

No pre-cutting needed to get ready for class.

Remember this is "just for fun", so you will cut and sew, and sew, and just make a fun, no stress quilt in class. Not your heirloom quilt, but just fun -- and could be really cozy if you use a flannel jelly roll!

Be sure you bring your remaining fabric for this project along with your sewing machine and all it's parts, cutter, cutting mat, and rulers. (Anything else you might need!)
