**Mochi - 60" x 60"**

this is a simple beginners quilt that even the most experienced quilter will enjoy it may be a simple quilt, but we'll talk about color and contrast and how a simple block can be turned into something unpredictable

**experience level** beginner and beyond

### **tool box**

sewing machine, in good working order, with manual  
 small scissors and thread snippers  
 cutting mat and 6-1/2 x 24" ruler and medium 9-1/2" square ruler  
 rotary cutter with new blade (45 or 28mm)  
 piecing threads in neutral grey, 3-5 loaded bobbins of the same thread  
 beyond the reef pattern - Mochi

pens, notebook, camera

### **fabrics**

"mochi" accents - 12 fat eighths (or fabrics rom your stash!)  
 background - 12 fat quarters  
 (for binding and backing, refer to pattern)

note for fabric selections: use a colorful group of "mochi" fabrics  
 paired with a neutral background - either of black and white prints  
 or a series of tonal greys with some contrast to the colors  
 bring your stash, and we can work on final quilt selections!!!

### **miscellaneous**

bring any other items necessary for your own personal comfort  
 we will be creating these big blocks with a lot of hands on machine time

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
