Sarah Fielke	Stitch your own quirky little suburb with this charming quilt. No precision, no templates - bring your imagination and your sense of fun to learn these improv houses, people and some other fun touches to personalise your quilt.
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sarah@sarahfielke.com	The requirements given below are for what you will need on the day, and also at home to finish your quilt. In class, we will work on dolls and houses, but also on trees and fences and pretty much whatever else you can think of to add character to your suburb. Please bring a good range of scraps so you have different colours to work with. Everyone will learn the techniques needed to make the different components of the quilt at home.

Sewing Machine Required	Fabric Selection
Yes	Background fabrics should have good contrast to the fabric for the objects. We will make trees, roofs, faces and legs - so think about greens for trees, browns for trunks etc, and fabrics that can be used for faces and hands, as well as the main fabrics for dresses. These can be quite patterned, as long as they are different to the fabric for the main house or dress so that they can be distinguished in the piecing.
	Material Requirements
	These requirements are for the whole quilt. Please note that they are approximate due to the improvisational nature of the quilt. You will not need to bring all this on the day - a yard of background and a good mix of bits and pieces for dresses, faces, legs, houses, roofs, trees and trunks....
	1 2/3 yards total for background of whole quilt (the fabric that will link your blocks together)
	1 2/3 yards total of background for behind the dolls, houses etc
	1 1/8 yards total for houses
	1/4 yard fabric for dolls faces and hands
	1/2 yard contrasting fabric for roofs, dolls legs, tree trunks etc
	Lots of small pieces of lovely things to piece your pictures with! You will want each piece for dresses and houses to be at least 6" square. Fat 16's are ideal.

Also bring your basic sewing and cutting supplies

#### Required Book or Pattern

The pattern for this quilt is in the book, Material Obsession One.

Each student needs their own copy of the book.
