Course Overview

Learn the basics of English Paper Piecing with the most beloved shape, the hexagon. In this class we will learn the basics and a few intermediate techniques to create fun fruit blocks from my new Fruit Basket EPP Pattern. Choose your favorite fruit from the pattern and get stitching!

Fabric Selection

Select one fruit block and bring enough fabric for one fruit. A selection of scraps and a fat quarter of background fabric is a great start.

Check the fabric requirements on the pattern for making the whole Fruit Basket quilt if wanting to make more than one block.

Required Pattern

Fruit Basket EPP Pattern with templates

Required Supplies

hand sewing needles - I use size 9 Milliner's needles (a mix pack with 8, 9 and 11 is ideal)

thread - I use Wonderfil Decobob 80wt Poly

water soluble glue stick and refill (Bohin, Sewline, Fons & Porter, Sue Daley)

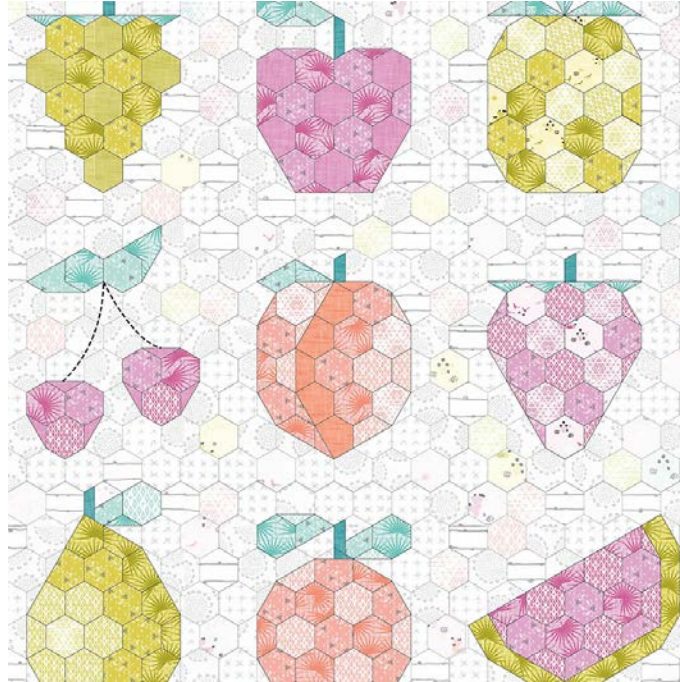
paper scissors

fabric scissors

fabric - bring enough for one fruit block

pencil and straight edge
