Course Overview

Tangelo is triangles made easy! There's no need for special rulers or a ton of precise pre-cutting, paper piecing is the perfect way to tackle this project! Thanks to paper piecing, we'll tackle this precise-looking project without having to stress out about it. The workshop will cover the paper piecing technique, ways to think about planning your fabric and color choices, as well as learning some tips and tricks to add to your paper piecing skillset.

Fabric Selection

Quilting cotton is perfect for this project, but you don't have to shy away from including linen or other wovens in your project. Paper piecing is a great technique for working with different types of fabric. The paper acts as a stabilizer when assembling your blocks. If desired, bring something directional or novelty to practice fussy cutting and more deliberate placement in the second half of class.

Required Fabrics (choose either the runner or wall quilt for your class project)



For the Runner (24" x 18") you need the following fabric amounts

5/8 yard or three ¼ yard cuts for the triangle fabric

5/8 yard background

3/4 yard backing and ¼ yard binding

For the Wall Quilt (24" x 34") you need the following fabric amounts

1 yard or five ¼ yard cuts for the triangle fabric

1 1/4 yard background

1 yard backing and 3/8 yard binding

Required Pattern

Tangelo Quilt Pattern

Required Supplies

paper templates for class (see prep note below)

rotary cutter and cutting mat

ruler (4"x14" is great)

scissors for cutting paper

pins and thread (match to your lightest fabric) for project

Optional Supplies

seam roller (optional) or finger press

lightbox (optional) (I prefer ** Daylight Wafer and translucent cutting mat. I'll be demoing this project on a Daylight Wafer 1 with translucent cutting mat

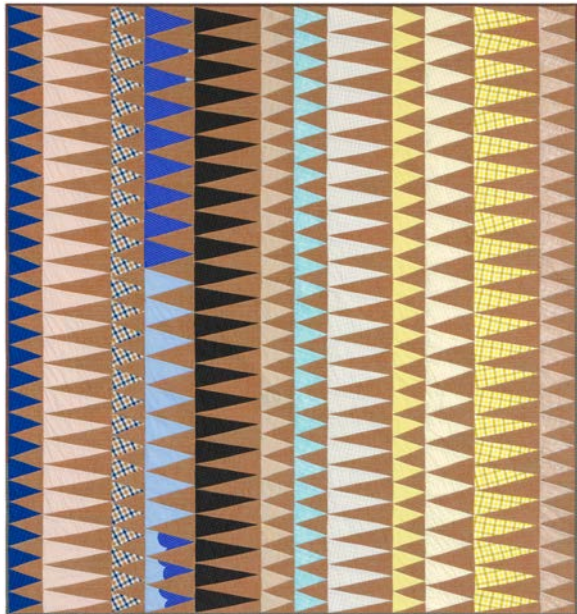
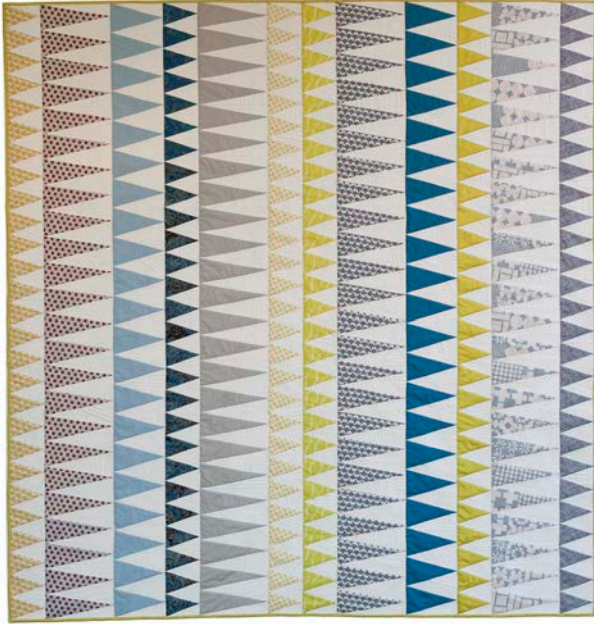
** Colored pencils and tracing paper (a coloring page will be provided in class)

Class Prep

Print block template papers before arriving in class. for class on to preferred paper. I use recycled office paper, but you can find other options at the quilt shop. Block amounts can be found in the pattern under "Preparation". Runner or Wall sized project amounts will be great for class.

Fabric strips for blocks can be pre-cut prior to class according to "Cutting Directions" in the instructions. We'll discuss the sub-cutting part (next step) them in class.
