Experience Level	You want there to be a good amount of contrast between your precut strips
Beginner	and your background fabric. Other than that there are no rules for this one!
Sewing Machine Required	Fabric Supplies
	30-2%" x width of Fabric (WOF) strips, a design roll works great for this
Yes	$30-5^{\prime\prime}$ x 5 $^{\prime\prime}$ charm squares, these can but do not have to be identical fabrics to the strips above
	2 ½ yards background fabric
	Additional Supplies
	Sewing Machine
	** ¼ inch foot for sewing machine
	Full size scissors
	Rotary cutter

Quilters ruler – as least 6" x 6" square

Coordinating cotton thread – I prefer Aurifil 50 wt

Please pre-cut your background strips. Cut thirty to forty 2 1/2" x 40" strips from your background fabric. Bring the leftover scraps of background fabric with you to class.
