Course Overview

Create a small fabric panel and make it magical by transforming it with hand and machine stitching. Using different weight and colors of thread explore ways of enhancing your fabric into a unique individual piece of fabric art while you relax and discover the possibilities of combining machine and hand work with fabric and thread.

Required Supplies

Sewing machine with normal sewing feet

Basic sewing and cutting supplies

A variety of embroidery threads you like and needles to accommodate them. Fabric markers of your choice, open toed embroidery foot, any pictures or books about stitching or embroidery.



Class Prep

Look at books, websites, pictures, actual stitched textiles to see how fabric and stitch are being use NOW. Bring any that inspire you to class.

Fabric Selection

Bring enough fabric in a color palette of your choice to make a pieced and or applied piece approximately 20" x 20". Make sure to include fabrics that will allow thread to show up such as solids in a range of values, stripes and dots as well as prints.
