Course Overview

In this class we will take a simple curved block and mix it up using all different methods of patchwork. You will learn some great tips and tricks on sewing curves.

Then we will explore using colors to make each block shine in a different way. Once the blocks are sewn up we'll explore different ways to put the finished blocks together to create a design that's uniquely yours!

Required Supplies and Notions

28 mm rotary cutter

50 or 80 weight thread

Sewline (or your favorite) glue stick

Sewing Machine with a narrow piecing foot or a quarter inch foot with NO seam guide

Fabric Selection

4 – 8 Fat quarters in contrasting colors or prints. Make sure you like them and they go well together. You can do each block in the same colorway or mix it up and do them all different. NOTE: these blocks finish at different sizes. If you'd like to do a "sampler" and make sure they all fit together, please email ahead of time and we will work at it together!

½ yard of a neutral background color

Optional Supplies

Glashead fine pins (optional but used frequently and recommended)

Square up rulers in 3 1/2, 4 1/2, 5 1/2, and 6 1/2 – I prefer Creative Grids

Spinning Cutting Mat (optional but used frequently and recommended)
I recommend Sky Hawk brand
