You will learn from me Stacy’s tried and true wool appliqué technique and various stitches to enhance your project. Learn how a touch of fabric and buttons can make a statement on this 16” x 20” design. This is sure to be keepsake and will adorn your sewing room for years to come!

## Required Supplies

#22 or #24 Chenille needles

Small and large sharp scissors – the type of scissors with small serrations

Thread kit

Button pack

Soft Fuse - either 18” or 36” wide

Pencil

Small cutting mat

Small ruler

Rotary cutter

Pellon Shapeflex SF101 (at least 16” x 20”) needed for the back of the project

### Required Kit Fee

Kit will include full size color pattern, wool, fabric and wood quilt block. Kit fee is \$72 and payable day of class

### Optional Supplies

Button packs, thread packs and frames are also available for purchase.
