Course Overview

Create a little house quilt and receive a degree in Architecture from the Chicago School of Fusing at the same time!

In this workshop we explore the many techniques of fusing: free cutting, layering, collage building, improvisational design, and more. The result is a whimsical neighborhood placed in a colorful landscape setting and made from beautifully hand-dyed fabrics.

Required Supplies

2 yards of regular weight Wonder-Under fusible web (paper backed, #805). Please DO NOT BRING HEAT 'N BOND or STEAM A SEAM

** 1 yard of parchment paper

Sharp fabric scissors

Paper scissors

Rotary cutters, mat and ruler

Batting, 1 piece measuring about 18" x 18"

Quilt backing fabric, 1 piece measuring about 18" x 18"

Small plastic bag for fabric scraps

** Supplies not carried by The Stitchin' Post

Required kit includes hand out, hand dyed fabrics and threads, and an embroidery needle.

Optional Supplies

Specialty rotary cutter blades like Pinking, Wavy or Scallop,

Tweezers (optional but helpful)

Thimble (optional but helpful)
