Course Overview

After visiting a refugee camp in Uganda, Africa, I came home with the desire to design a quilt honoring the women and children living in squalor and poverty. Your quilt can reflect your thoughts on living in a camp.

Required Supplies

BSS, sewing machine in good working order, freezer paper and scissors, appliques threads and needles. Lots of small pieces of fabric for building your huts and creatively surrounding them. Not all fabrics have to be African prints, solids, textures and modern prints work in well. One half yards of fabrics for borders, not all borders have to be the same. It is the African way.

Optional Supplies

Any buttons or beads needed as finishing adornments. (example; Zebra buttons)
