sarah@sarahfielke.com	The requirements given below are for what you will need on the day, and also at home to finish your pouch. In class, we will likely finish most, if not all, of the pouch front. If you are a quick worker, please feel free to bring everything for your pouch so we can put the zipper in, or enough fabric for both pouch fronts. Everyone will learn the techniques needed to make the different components of the pouch at home.

<b>Sewing Machine Required</b>	<b>Required Material and Supplies</b>
Yes	Fat quarter for the top strip and the back of the pouch  Various large scraps of four different fabrics for the pieced backgrounds of the pouch. These fabrics can be several different shades of the same colour, or prints that have GOOD CONTRAST to the fabric you choose for your letters. You will need approx. 30cm (1/3 yard) in total, but bring extra - you will be surprised how much fabric you need for improv!  10" (25cm) approx for letters. Please make sure that there is very good contrast between the letter fabric and the background fabric or you will not be able to read what you write. One premade template from the pouch shape attached, cut from template plastic. Please DO NOT cut this shape from fabric yet.  Basic sewing and cutting supplies  Things you will need afterwards at home to complete your pouch: 10" (25cm) for pouch lining 14" plastic zipper (plastic teeth not metal) 40cm (16") x 90cm (36") piece fusible fleece for stabilizer Zipper foot for your sewing machine  <b>Required Book</b>  Stitch Your Story -- available March, 2019
