### Course Overview

In this workshop participants will receive a selection of shapes, which I have drawn, to create their own unique applique block.

This workshop will cover the following topics: selecting fabrics, making templates, back basting method, and needle turn appliqué.

### Fabric Selection

1 fat quarter for background

A variety of small pieces of coloured fabrics (florals, spots, stripes, etc) for appliqué. Fat 16th, Fat 8th and small pieces/scrap work well

### Required Supplies

Requirements for hand appliqué

1 fat quarter for background

80 wt Cotton threads to match in variety of colours – My preference is Aurifil

\*\* Mechanical pencil 0.7mm with 2B lead

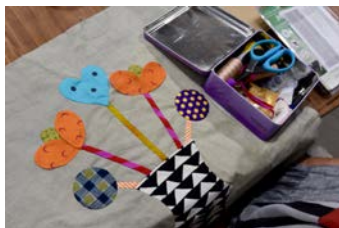
Straw or milliners needle size 11

Appliqué pins

Template plastic (a slightly thicker one works best) and old scissors for cutting plastic

\*\* Ultra fine permanent marker. I like the sharpie brand (they don't smudge much)

Fabric scissors



\*\* Sandpaper board or a piece of medium grade sandpaper

Roxanne's Glue Baste It

Silver Gel Pen

\*\* **Supplies not carried by The Stitchin' Post**
