Course Overview

This class is all about making useful (and beautiful) sewing stuff like pincushions and thread catchers. Techniques to make the projects will be covered as well as instruction and ideas for embroidery and other customizations. You will go home with finished sewing stuffs.

Fabric Selection

Anything can work for this—from blenders to fussy-cuttable motifs, linens and other sturdy wovens. Students can bring a mix, and we'll discuss different ways to use them.

Required Fabrics

fabric: For Crew Pincushions, see pattern cover for fabric requirements (attached)

For Thread catcher—2 fat eighths (9"x21), 1 for exterior fabric, 1 for lining fabric.

Required Supplies

rotary cutter and cutting mat

ruler

pins

hand sewing needle

thread

pincushion filling (ground walnut shells is great)

removable marking tool (such as Pilot Frixion pen)



Optional Supplies

interfacing (such as SF101, 1/2 yard)

embroidery floss, quilting thread or pearl cotton

embroidery needle, quilting needle

thimble

stiletto

Class Prep

purchase supplies and bring them to class

SAVOR EACH STITCH.

Like how you'd want different pins for different projects, the perfect pincushion is also a variable need depending on the function, the pin itself, the location (traveling requires a separate set of needs!) and the cuteness. (Duh.)

G (single fabric–small) 3" l. x 2" w. x ¾" h.	1 FE	-
H (single fabric–large) 3" l. x 2½" w. x 1½" h.	(1) 10" square	-
I (triangle–small) 2½" l. x 2" w. x 2" h.	(1) 10" square	-
J (triangle–medium) 3½" l. x 3½" w. x 3" h.	(1) 10" square	-
K (triangle–large) 4½" l. x 4½" w. x 4" h.	(1) 10" square	-

+ 11 pincushions to choose from!
+ Fast, fun and super functional project.
+ Detailed notes and ideas about embellishment, decorative piecing, quilting, and filling options—all included.
+ Great for gifts—show your sewing friends some love.

Featured fabrics are from my Euclid and Carkai collections with Robert Kaufman.

+ **Materials** : Measurements assume 42"-wide fabric.
FE = Fat Eighth (9" x 21")

*If piecing the contrast section, you'll need small scraps of two different fabrics.

+ **Interfacing (optional)** : If not using linen or other sturdy fabric, you might consider using interfacing (such as Pellon SF101) and/or quilting your pieces before assembly. Adjust amounts as needed.

+ **Additional Supplies + Tools** : sewing thread, hand needle, removable marking tool, rotary cutter, cutting mat, rulers, 5/32" eyelet and eyelet tool (for F), 1 yard cording (for F), ground walnut shells or other filling (wool batting scraps, polyfil or emery sand), stiletto (optional), embroidery floss (optional)
