

# Overgrown

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**Overgrown** explores mixing organic style applique with pieced structure. Here we have a Court House Steps foundation with one round of applique done with big, easy shapes. In class we will talk about contrasting colors and explore a few techniques for easy applique using Wash Away Applique paper. The fabrics used in the sample are from Kaffe Fassett and my range called Celebrate.

Size: 84" x 88"

**Materials:** When selecting your fabrics consider cool blues and greens as well as warm pinks, reds and oranges. Include some darker value prints for the applique. Some of the strips can also be used for applique.

10" Centre rectangle (also used for some applique)

Cool prints for side strips:

4-6" of three cool prints  
8" of four cool prints

Warm prints for top and bottom  
6" of three warm prints  
8" of three warm prints  
12" of one warm print

Applique Border  
1 1/2 yds - Pink (Warm Spot)  
1 1/2 yds - Blue (Cool Spot)

Outer border strips  
3/4 yd of first round  
1 yd of second round  
1 yd of third round

2/3 yd of stem fabric  
An assortment of fabrics for the applique including a variety of dark, medium and cool colours

Outer borders:

1/2 yd of three prints  
3/4 yd Binding

Supplies:  
Best Press  
Glue Baste  
1m Applique Wash Away  
Applique threads, needles and scissors  
3-4 Perle 8 for quilting

General sewing supplies: mat, ruler, measuring ruler, pins  
\*Paper and pencil for sketching and camera  
\*Design wall

**Note: items marked with \* will not be carried at either The Stitchin' Post or the school store at the high school.**
