

ART BOWLS

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CLASS DESCRIPTION

Create a three dimensional art piece in the shape of a bowl.

Starting with heavy duck canvas, you will shape a bowl, decorate with your own design and embellishments and finish it with a coat of thread work.

Size of finished bowl is approximately 16" diameter.

LEVEL OF EXPERIENCE: All

CLASS DURATION: 2 days

TOOL / SUPPLY LIST:

Sewing machine able to Satin stitch or Zigzag

Needles size 80/12 or 90/14, SHARP and METALLIC

Open embroidery foot or Zigzag foot, free motion embroidery foot (optional)

Extra bobbins

Fabric scissors, paper scissors, seam ripper

Rotary cutter and cutting mat

Pencil, note pad, ruler

5 sheets of white paper (8x10)

½ yard of fabric for outside of bowl (batik preferred but not required)

Lots of fabric scraps

½ yard heavy duck canvas – 18 oz. weight. **NOTE: the Stitchin Post will carry this item for class**

4 yards Wonder Under – *in my experience, this is the best fusible for this project as we deal with many layers of canvas, fusible and fabric.* **NOTE: the Stitchin Post will carry this item for class**

Decorative threads – polyester, cotton or rayon

Teflon sheet (desired but not mandatory)

INSPIRATION:

A quilt, photo, sketch, basketry, glass art, ceramic art, etc. Anything you would like to replicate in a bowl.
