

Two (or Three) Color Mystery Quilter's Affair July 10th, 2018

Class Overview: You will be working on a 60" x 60" quilt using three fabrics, one of which is the background. Fabrics are being referred to as fabric #1, fabric #2, and the background.

If you only want to choose two fabrics, one of which is the background, that is fine. You will need to make sure you get the total yardage amount for fabric #1 and fabric #2 which is 3 3/4 yards and this includes binding.

Following the cutting directions, anything that says to cut from fabric #2, you will cut it from fabric #1.

Fabric List for the entire project:

Fabric #1 — 2 1/2 yards and this includes the binding

Fabric #2 — 1 yard

Background — 1 1/2 yards

And for finishing you will need 4 yards quilt backing and 66" x 66" quilt batting

Note: yardage amounts given allow a bit extra figured in case you might need another strip to cut your needed pieces.

Material List:

the Omnigrd 96L half-square triangle ruler will be used for cutting the pieces for this quilt.

If you have an Easy Angle ruler, this will also work.

your sewing machine and all it's parts, especially the foot pedal and cord!

rotary cutter, mat, ruler, and your other basic sewing supplies.

some like to bring a pillow to sit on — or even a quilt — if you like to sit a bit higher in your chair

PRE-CLASS CUTTING:

Note: all of these measurements are based on you using your half-square triangle ruler.

Using it, you do not make as many cuts and I find that the cuts are more accurate, which is always good.

From Fabric #1 cut 15 - 4 1/2" strips.

From Fabric #2 cut 3 - 4 1/2" x 42" strips.

Also cut 6 - 2 1/2" x 42" strips. (If you are only using Fabric #1 and the background you do not need to cut these 2 1/2" strips).

From the Background cut 9 - 4 1/2" strips.

That's all the pre-class preparation you need to do.
