Supplies Participants Should Bring:

- Batting, 1 piece of wool (recommended) or other hand quilting type of batting measuring 9" x 6"
- Parchment paper measuring about 24" long
- Thimble (optional but helpful)
- Scissors
- Needle threader (optional)
- Thread Heaven thread conditioner (optional)
