Class Description:

Learn how to take the traditional Pineapple log cabin block and give it a modern twist through improvisation. Students will also learn the paneling method to put blocks together using an alternate grid structure. The fabric amount in the supply list will make the Quirky Pineapple quilt that finishes at approximately 48" x 48". Making more or less blocks or changing the block size can make the quilt larger or smaller. Adjust your fabric amounts accordingly. Backing and binding fabrics are not included in fabric amounts.

The more fabric you bring, the more flexibility you will have to improvise.

Each student will need a personal design wall. If design walls are not available in the classroom, bring 2 yards of white flannel, a flannel backed table cloth, or a portable design wall if you have one available.

Materials:

Sewing machine

Standard quilting and rotary cutting tools and supplies plus:

2 1/3 yards of background fabric (white in the inspiration quilt)

6 fat quarters of one color in 6 different values from light to dark. (pink in the inspiration quilt)
