

# Sew All the Curves + Design

In this class we are first going to learn some basics for sewing curves. I suggest scrap fabric- fabric that you don't really love. (We all have some of that right?!)

The second part of the class we'll talk about design and how you can use curves to create all different blocks like the example shown. You'll pick a few of the examples and we'll walk through how to make them and put them into a quilt. This is an intermediate skill level class.



## Kit Fee

\$16 for a curved 3 ½" and 6 ½" template

## Sewing Supplies

- 28 mm rotary cutter
- Spinning Cutting Mat (optional but used frequently and recommended)
- 50 or 80 weight thread
- Fine pins (optional but used frequently and recommended)
- Sewline (or your favorite) glue stick
- Square up rulers in 3.5 and 6.5 (optional but used frequently and recommended)

## Fabric Requirements

- 5-10 pieces of scrap fabric at least 8 inches square for practicing
- 4-6 Fat Quarters for each block in the example (feel free to use the same fabric)
- 1 yard for background fabric
