Pincushion - Sally Frey Workshop 320/420

Lap size: 41" X 45"

What quilter wouldn't want this quilt hanging in their sewing room? It is a two day class of designing a collage quilt that will be your favorite. The first day we will do the design basics and spend the second day decorating you pincushion.

Supply List:

You don't need a sewing machine for this class.

You must buy the pattern "Pincushion" by Laura Heine (available on The Stitchin' Post website)

1 ½ yard Pattern Ease Foundation

8 yards of 24" wide Steam a Seam 2 fusible

(I thought no way would I use eight yards of steam a seam, I bought 5 yards and had to buy 3 more yards)

Applique Pressing Sheet

Sharp scissors (Laura recommends Karen Buckley Medium blue handle scissors)

Fabrics:

 $1\frac{3}{4}$ yards total of background fabrics, pinks to creams, wovens, florals & scripts

Scraps or 1/8's of 11 different reds, pinks, purples for pincushion

Scraps or 1/8's of 4 different greens for pincushion

Scraps or 1/8's of 17 different florals in colors blues, pinks, yellows, whites

Scraps of dark gray/black for needles & pins

Before class trace the pattern on the Pattern Ease using a black sharpie pen
