Supplies Needed:

Machine Ready for Piecing

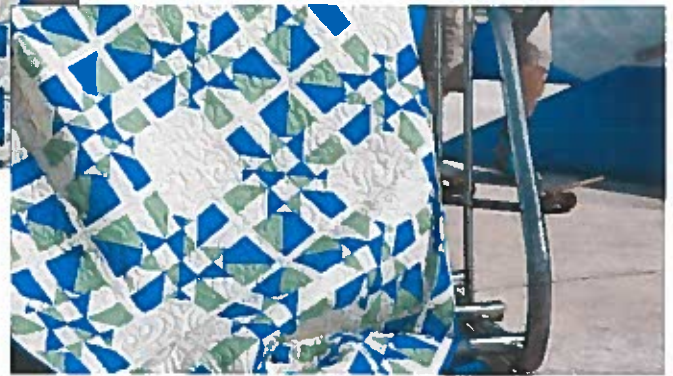
Background color (white) - 1 pack 10" x 10" (or 4 packs at 5" x 5")

Plus 1 pack of 1 1/2" x 44" pre-cut skinny strips.

Fabric 1 (Blue) - 2 Packs 5" x 5" Precuts

Fabric 2 (Green) - 2 Packs 5" x 5" Precuts

Longer Ruler - at least 18 inches
Cutting Mat
Rotary cutter
Thread for piecing.

It is the perfect job for me, and I had always wanted to try a reverse appliqué quilt. I really enjoyed the freeform prep work and sewing style of this project and should make for a perfect one day workshop.

It is very basic construction, yet a very dramatic finish in just a few hours of work.

This workshop focuses on the basic Quarter Square Triangle done in a super simple way. It is best to work from pre-cut fabrics, and the more solid reading your fabrics, the easier it will be to keep track of your placements.

Feel free to work from your stash and be creative in your fabric choices, but do try to think in solids for the dramatic affect in this project.
